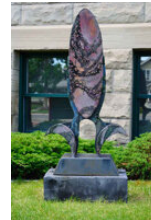

What year was the Paris Gibson Square building built?

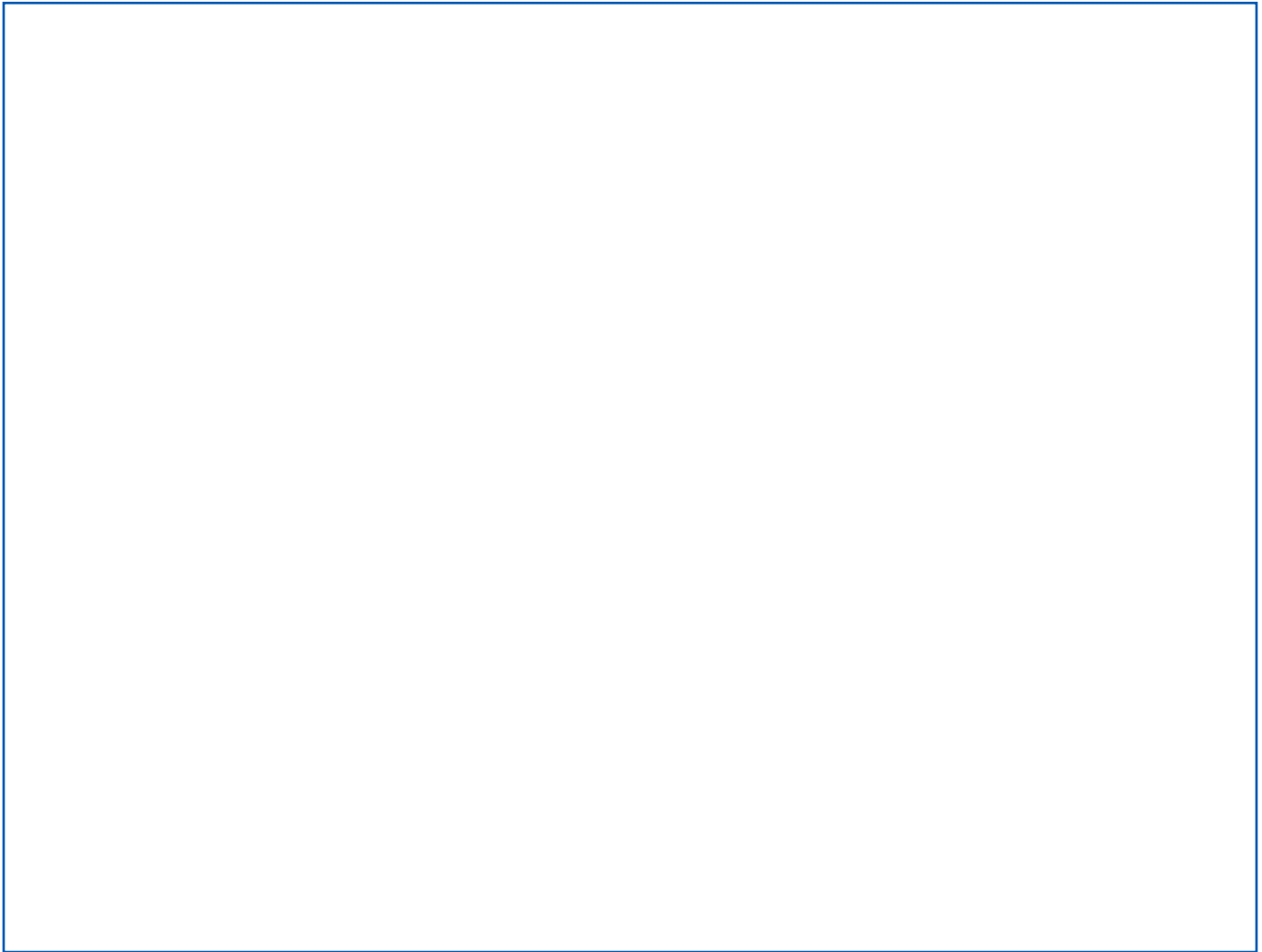
